

The cat show will be held in the spacious 12,221sf Royal Palm Ballroom. It is carpeted and climate controlled with excellent lighting.

A concession service will be available for lunch. There is also a Pizza Hut in the hotel lobby. No outside food can be brought into the show hall.

General Show Information

Accessibility: The show hall is a non-smoking, climatecontrolled facility. The Park Inn meets ADA requirements for accessibility.

Benching Request: Only one benching request will be allowed. If you list more than one, only the first request will be considered. The entry clerk will make every attempt to bench your cats per your request, however, the club cannot guarantee that all benching requests can be honored due to space limitations and show hall configuration.

Handicapped exhibitors will receive preferential and 'free' benching for end-of-row requests. All other end-of-row requests will be benched on a first-come, first-served space available basis at a cost of \$20.

Benching & Supplies: The first entry includes a double cage space that is 22"x 22" x 45". Benching is sold in increments of double cage space only! A grooming space is the same size as a double cage space.

Other Cage Requirements: Top, floor, sides, back and bottom of the cage must be covered. Per TICA rules, only I cat or 2 kittens per I/2 double, and 2 cats or 4 kittens per double cage.

Exhibition/For Sale cages are \$49. These are double cages and are available to exhibitors who have at least one cat entered for competition. Any cats or kittens for sale must be owned by the same paid exhibitor. Kittens must be at least three (3) calendar months of age. Proof of age must be provided upon request. No kittens or cats may be confined to carriers during show hours. Florida requires health certificates accompany any animal sold in the state. Sandy Claws Cat Fanciers takes no responsibility for your failure to familiarize yourself with applicable Florida statutes. Health Certificates must be available for review if requested.

Ring Clerks: If interested in clerking at the show, please contact the entry clerk. Clerks receive \$40/day, are provided lunch, and a marked catalog by email. Clerks may not deduct anticipated clerking payment from entry fees.

Stewards: If interested in stewardings, please contact the entry clerk. Stewards receive \$20/day and lunch.

Registration: With the exception of cats competing in the Preliminary New Breed, Advanced New Breed, and New Traits classes, registration with TICA is not necessary in

order to compete in the cat's first show, but is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for TICA Regional and International Awards after the cat's first TICA show.

<u>Kittens:</u> To compete, all kittens must be 4 calendar months old (born on or before February 15, 2018). To be allowed in the show hall for exhibition and/or for sale, kittens must be 3 calendar months old (born on or before March 15, 2018). Altered kittens are eligible for entry.

Household Pets (HHP's)— HHP's over the age of 7 months of age must be spayed or neutered. If you are unsure of your cat's color, please send a color photo of your cat along with your entry. Printed photos will be returned at check-in

Preliminary New Breeds and Advanced New Breeds

- According to TICA Show Rule 203.19, Preliminary New

 According to TICA Show Rule 203.19, Preliminary New Breeds (PNB) and Advanced New Breeds (ANB) must have a TICA registration number prior to entering any TICA show.
 PNB/ANB can't be shown as a "registration pending" status.

Health — This is a non-vetted show. Cats showing signs of ear mites, fleas, fungus, or any other illness will not be permitted in the show hall. Front and back claws must be clipped. All entries should be immunized against feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and feline enteritis, and should test negative for feline leukemia and feline AIDS. Any cat or kitten from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days prior to the opening date of the show is ineligible for entry and/or exhibition. Any cat which is obviously pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws (front and back) must be clipped prior to judging. Declawed cats are eligible for competition, although this practice is not sanctioned. Florida laws requires any animal over the age of 4 months be vaccinated against rabies within the last 12 months. Proof of current rabies vaccination might be requested.

Liability— The show management shall take all reasonable care of cats, carriers and other personal property of exhibitors, but it is expressly stipulated that neither the show management, nor any member of the club, nor the club sponsoring the show can be held liable for the loss of or accident to the cats, carriers, or other personal properties of any exhibitor. Neither Sandy Claws Cat Fanciers, TICA, and the Park Inn by Radisson Resort & Conference Center may be held liable for loss, theft, or damage to animals, personal property, exhibitors or their guests, vendors or spectators in attendance.

Sponsorship Opportunities

Maine Coon Congress—\$250/ring (3 available) or \$750/for all 3 rings — This sponsorship helps defray the cost of the Maine Coon Congresses (specialty rings on Friday afternoon/evening). Junior Exhibitor "JE" Judging Ring (I Available) — \$75 — The JE Program is a way you can contribute to TICA's future. JE's are verbally tested on their skills as they present their cats to the audience, including their knowledge of cat husbandry and of showing their cats in TICA. Support the JE's with your donation which offsets the cost of special rosettes and the judge's fee. Sponsorship includes a listing on the website, I/4 page ad in the Exhibitor Catalog, acknowledgement in the Exhibitor Catalog and by the JE judge (if they remember).

Closing Dates, Payments & Fees

All entries must be received and paid by 9:00m Eastern Time Monday, June 11, 2018. All entries received after this date/time will be refused! There will be NO LATE PAGES!

All fees/services for the show are due and payable within 7 days of entry, unless arrangements are made with the entry clerk.

By completing a summary sheet OR entering cats in the show, you agree to pay all fees whether you attend the show or not.

All fees must be paid in U.S. funds. Make money orders and bank checks payable to "Sandy Claws Cat Fanciers". Only checks issued from a United States bank can be accepted. No post-dated checks will be accepted. Returned check fee: \$35 plus any bank fees charged the club.

NO REFUNDS! Once an entry or service request has been received, only substitutions may be made until the entry deadline. Any excess payment will be considered a donation to the show.

Cats co-owned by members of two different households are eligible for multiple entry discounts only if a photocopy of the cat's TICA registration accompanies the cat's entry showing the names of both coowners.

End-of-row benching (not handicapped) fee — \$20. Extra catalog — \$10.

Late fee — Any exhibitor whose payment has not been received for any reason prior to the entry deadline of the show (10pm, Monday, June 10, 2018) will be assessed a \$25 late fee. Payment at the door will be at the sole discretion of the Entry Clerk, will be subject to the \$25 late fee, and MUST be paid in cash. No exceptions!
